Who can be a MPRD volunteer?

Almost anyone can volunteer. Moms, dads, sisters, brothers, grandparents, even friends. We need women and men, young, middle-aged, and young at heart folks. MPRD wants volunteers who want to help make our program a fun experience for kids. Previous coaching experience is <u>NOT</u> necessary to assist our organization.

What does a volunteer coach do?

Aside from coaching sports skills and developing a fun, team building atmosphere, MPRD volunteer coaches are our link to the team. You will communicate game/practice schedules, organize occasional practices and bring equipment to and from the field. You'll also help deliver team uniforms and coordinate picture day. Overall, you help keep everyone organized. MPRD will provide all of the equipment, league rules and schedules via a preseason coaches meeting.

How much time commitment does it involve?

Typically, 4 year old and Kindergarten coaches simply meet once per week with their team for about an hour for about 7 weeks. 1/2 grade, 3/4 grade and 5/6 grade coaches will typically have 1-2 practices prior to the season and play one hour games twice/week for about 7 weeks. Overall, it's a very limited time commitment with a huge reward!
